If it were an unstable political situation, terrorism, a natural disaster (such as tsunami or earthquake), then there will be no more tourists and therefore no income. This is exactly what happened to Egypt after a series of unlucky events (revolution in 2011, a military coup in 2013 and a series of disasters of the airline). Egypt was always a country that attracted millions of people from all over the world for its ancient monuments and rich history. However, now you can enjoy the tomb of Tutankhamun for you. The owners of hotels and restaurants had to reduce prices to attract the few customers. And local artisans had to find other means to make money, as no one is there to buy their products. However, an earthquake of 2015 has completely destroyed the valley, bury all the villages under the landslides and rubble. Now it's a city that alive with nightlife. The same happens with a sound of pollution. With growth and development the noise comes from people, cars, bars and nightlife. Both the light and sound pollution create an adverse environment for animals that live in that area, pushing them away from their original habitat. We should not forget the sewers. Sewers, Cleaning systems must develop a much larger quantity of wastewater. A growing numbr of people who constantly adds the pressure. And unfortunately, some places Dona t have all the cleaning systems in place, and the wastewater go to the sea untreated.
