In this tutorial, we'll show you how you can remove your credit card or other payment method information from Safari, Apple ID, and Apple Pay on your iPhone or iPad. If you have an iPhone, then chances are you have a credit card tied to your device in some way, shape, or form. Whether you're using it for purchasing apps with your Apple ID, linking it to use for NFC-based Apple Pay payments, or saving it to make payments through Safari with AutoFill, then you've got your credit card information stashed with Apple. Because credit card information is one of those things you probably try to keep safe from identity thieves and malware threats, its understandable that you might have a conscience about removing them from your tech. Alternatively, it's also possible that the added credit card is now expired, or you just want to switch to a different one. Here are all the different ways to remove your credit card information from your iPhone. Note that removing it from your Apple ID and Apple Pay will also affect your other Apple devices where you use these services. From your Apple ID: The most common place for your credit card information to be stored is in your Apple ID settings. This is the credit card that will be billed any time you buy apps, in-app purchases, subscriptions, movies, music, ringtones, and more from Apples digital content stores. Follow these steps to remove a credit card thats already been associated with your Apple ID: 1) Open the iPhone Settings app and tap your Apple ID name from the top. 2) Tap Payment & Shipping and enter your Apple ID password if asked. 3) You will now see all the payment methods added to your Apple ID. Select the card or payment method you want to remove. 4) Tap Remove Payment Method. Note that you can also tap Edit in Step 3, hit the red minus icon for a payment method, and tap Remove. Related tutorials: From Apple Pay: Another place where your credit card information could be stored is in your Apple Pay settings. This is the credit card that gets billed any time you make an Apple Pay purchase through a supported app or when you make an NFC purchase at a retailer that supports near-field communication payments at the register. Follow these steps to delete a credit card thats associated with your Apple Pay: 1) Launch the Settings app on your iPhone. 2) Scroll down and tap Wallet & Apple Pay. 3) Next, tap the credit card you want to remove from Apple Pay. 4) Scroll all the way down and tap the red Remove Card button. 5) In the pop-up prompt that appears, tap the red Remove button to confirm your choice. The selected credit card is now removed from Apple Pay on your iPhone! Related: Change the default payment method in Apple Pay From Safari: AutoFill: The other place a credit card might be stored on your iPhone is in your Safari settings, where you might have trained iOS to automatically fill up your personal data in web forms that require payment information to complete a purchase. Follow these steps to remove a credit card thats associated with your iPhones Safari web browser: 1) Open the Settings app and select Safari. 2) Tap the AutoFill cell. 4) Tap Saved Credit Cards to see all the cards you have saved here. 5) Swipe left on a saved card and tap Delete. Depending on the way iPhone is being used for payments, the Credit card information on your iPhone might be linked to your Apple ID, Apple Pay and it may also be stored by the Safari browser on your iPhone. Apple ID: Having your credit card information linked to Apple ID allows you to make purchases on App Store, iTunes and Apple Books. Apple Pay: Linking credit card to Apple Pay allows you to make both online and in-store contactless payments using iPhone. Safari Browser: Storing your credit card information in Safari browser allows you to make online purchases, without the need to manually fill your credit card details. Remove Credit Card from iPhone Now that we have identified the locations where your Credit card information might be stored on iPhone, let us go ahead and take a look at the steps to remove Credit Information from these locations on your iPhone. 1. Remove Credit Card from Apple ID Follow the steps below to edit or remove your Credit Card information from Apple ID. 1. Open Settings > tap on your Apple ID Name. 2. From Apple ID screen, go to Payment & Shipping > select the Credit Card that you want to remove. 3. On the next screen, tap on Edit (top-right) > scroll down and tap on the Delete option. Note: You wont be able to change or remove your Payment Information, if you have an unpaid balance or an upcoming due payment. 2. Remove Credit Card from Apple Pay If you had setup Apple Pay, you can follow the steps below to remove your credit card information from Apple Pay. 1. Go to Settings > Wallet & Apple Pay > select the Credit Card that you want to remove. 2. On the next screen, scroll down and tap on Remove Card option. 3. On the confirmation pop-up, tap on Remove to confirm. With these steps, you have successfully removed your credit card information from Apple Pay. 3. Remove Credit Card from Safari As mentioned above, your credit card information is also likely to be stored by the Safari browser on your iPhone. 1. Go to Settings > Safari > scroll down and tap on AutoFill option tab, located under General section. 2. On AutoFill screen, tap on Saved Credit Cards and enter your Lock Screen Passcode. 3. On the Credit Cards screen, select your Credit Card. 4. On the next screen, tap on the Edit option (top-right) and select Delete Credit Card option that appears. 4. On the confirmation pop-up, tap on the Delete option to confirm. After following these steps, you have successfully removed your Credit Card information from all possible locations on iPhone. You can also remove debit and credit cards from Apple Pay if your iPhone is lost or stolen. Note: If you sign out of iCloud in Settings > [your name], all your credit and debit cards for Apple Pay are removed from iPhone. You can add the cards again the next time you sign in to your Apple Account. Go to the Wallet app on your iPhone. Tap the card you want to remove, then tap Tap Card Details, then tap Remove Card. If you remove a card, you can add it again later. If you turned on Find My iPhone, you can use it to help locate and secure your iPhone. To remove your cards from Apple Pay, do any of the following: On another iPhone or iPad: Go to Settings > [your name], select the lost iPhone, then tap Remove Items (below Wallet & Apple Pay). Using a web browser: Sign in to your Apple Account. Click Devices, then select the lost device. In the Wallet & Apple Pay section, click Remove Items. Call the issuers of your cards. Helpful? Thanks for your feedback. Do you want to remove your credit card info from your phone for privacy reasons? Or do you want to remove them to add new credit card details? Regardless of the reason, there are several ways you can edit your card info on the iPhone. So, lets quickly jump to the content on how you can do exactly that. You can view and delete all your saved credit card information on your iPhone using the AutoFill feature, Apple ID, and Apple Pay. Lets take a look. One of the easiest and fastest ways to view and delete your credit cards on your phone is through your Apple ID. Since your Apple ID has all of your information and is the one you use to make purchases, you can also find your credit card details. If you want to remove your saved credit card from your Apple ID, heres what you can do: Open Settings and tap on your Apple profile. Select Payment and Shipping. Tap on a payment method and select Remove Payment. Another way you can view and delete your saved credit card is through Safaris AutoFill settings. Heres how you can do it: Go to Settings. Tap on Safari. From the General section, tap on AutoFill. Below the Credit Cards area, youll notice the Saved Credit Cards option. Your iPhones saved credit card information. If you want to delete your saved credit card from your phone, heres what you can do: Tap on your Credit Card info from the Saved Credit Cards option. Tap on the Edit option thats on the upper-right corner of the screen. Now, tap on Delete Credit Card. Your iPhone will ask you to verify your action. Tap on Delete again. Since its natural to use Apple Pay to make online transactions from your phone, you can remove your credit card from here as well. Heres are the steps you can take. Go to Settings. Tap on Wallet and Apple Pay. Select your desired Credit Card. Scroll down and select the Remove Card option. Youll get asked to verify your action. Tap again on Remove to confirm. Your iPhone doesnt store your credit card information on your phone, nor does it share your details with other accounts. Although other info, like the iCloud photos and Contacts, get synced across other Apple devices, your card info never gets synced. Besides that, there are additional security functions, like the Face ID and your passcode. With such security, anyone else cant easily access your credit card info and make purchases through Apple Pay. Whats more, you get an exclusive and secure Device Account Number from Apple Pay. So, your private info, like your credit card info, is very secure on the iPhone. However, we recommend being careful with sharing your phone with others. Its best not to let other people take screenshots or screen record on your phone. There are several ways you can prevent your child from making accidental in-game purchases. The best way to do this is by setting up the Ask to Buy feature on the device that your kids use. When you have this setting enabled, your kids will need your permission to make a purchase. Here are the steps you can follow on an iPhone or an iPad: Go to Settings. Tap on your Apple profile. Select Family Sharing. Tap on Ask to Buy. Select your kids name. Slide the toggle to turn on Ask to Buy. If youre on a Mac, here are the steps you can follow to turn on the Ask to Buy feature: Click on the Apple logo. Go to System Preferences. Select Family Sharing. Click on Ask to Buy from the sidebar. Tick the box thats beside your kids name. From now, next time you get a purchase request from your child, you can simply tap on Approve or Decline. Another way you can prevent your child from making purchases is by adding a passcode before every purchase. You can also use the Screen Time feature and make certain apps turn off after a set period of time. If you dont want to make your purchase history visible due to privacy concerns, here are the steps you can follow to hide them. Go to Settings. Tap on Wallet and select your card. Tap on the three dots and select Transactions. Select the option that says Turn Off Transaction History. If you want to view your complete Apple Pay history, you can do it using a statement from where you issued your card. You can remove a credit card from your iPhone with a few taps. The first payment card that you add to Apple Wallet on a device becomes your default card for that device. You can also change your default card when you add more cards. Open the Wallet app. Touch and hold the payment card that you want to set as your default card. Drag the card in front of your other cards. On your iPhone, open the Apple Watch app. In the My Watch tab, tap Wallet & Apple Pay. Under Transaction Defaults, tap Default Card. Tap a card to set it as your default card. On your device, open Wallet & Apple Pay settings. On your Mac with Touch ID, go to System Settings (or System Preferences) > Wallet & Apple Pay. On your iPad or Vision Pro, go to Settings > Wallet & Apple Pay. Select a new default card. On your Mac with Touch ID, choose a card from the menu.
